I. <u>BACKGROUND</u>

On December 5, 2023, Informational Memorandum <u>IS-23-003</u> was issued to detail actions RMA is taking as part of a broader set of commitments made by President Biden and Secretary Vilsack to increase domestic food production amid potential global food shortages related to the invasion of Ukraine. The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) is building on lessons learned in 2023 and continuing efforts to simplify sign-up and expand double cropping coverage availability for the 2024 crop year. These efforts will help enable agricultural producers to produce two crops on the same land each year, such as spring-planted soybeans or grain sorghum following the harvest of a crop such as winter wheat.

For the 2024 crop year, producers intending to plant soybeans or grain sorghum after wheat and other fall-seeded crops (double cropping) in counties where the Following Another Crop (FAC) practice is not available, may have the option to request coverage in select counties through their crop insurance agent. Additionally, producers in some areas of the country also have the option to request coverage for soybeans planted into wheat or camelina using a relay cropping practice. This memo provides details on the Blanket Written Agreement (BL) offers that are available in all counties that offer soybean coverage in the states of Illinois, Indiana, and Ohio in which the Following Another Crop (FAC) practice is not available for the 2024 crop year.

II. FAC Written Agreement Options and Requirements

A BL Offer is a standardized written agreement offer prebuilt by RMA into the Regional Office Exceptions (ROE) System which allows for a producer to choose to insure their FAC soybeans. Since the written agreement offer is prebuilt by RMA, a producer does not have to go through an extensive underwriting process and can simply choose to insure their FAC crop by submitting an actuarial change request (ACR) form through their agent and Approved Insurance Provider (AIP).

Each county has a unique written agreement number that AIPs can access. The BL in each county provides the terms and conditions of insurance available to producers interested in insuring FAC soybeans in the states of Illinois, Indiana, and Ohio for the 2024 crop year. The rates and T-yields for the FAC practice may vary by county just as they do for other insurable crops.

For all FAC soybeans insured under BL, the definition for FAC applies:

FAC (Following Another Crop): A planted crop following:

- 1. A perennial hay crop that was harvested in the same calendar year; and
- 2. A crop (other than a cover crop) that has reached the headed or budded stage prior to termination, regardless of the percentage of plants that reached the headed or budded stage;

Termination means growth has ended. A crop that follows a cover crop that meets the criteria outlined in the Insurance Availability section of the Special Provisions is considered NFAC.

The BL agreements available in the Illinois, Indiana, and Ohio do not provide coverage for organic or specialty type soybeans. Coverage for these types can be requested through the traditional written agreement request process.

III. Blanket Written Agreement Numbers

BL Offers were used previously with breeched levees, which is where the BL designator originated. See Exhibit A for BL Offer numbers for each county and each crop where they are offered.

IV. <u>Action</u>

Insureds can select a BL Offer by submitting a signed and dated ACR form for soybeans, where applicable, to their crop insurance agent by the sales closing date. AIPs may apply the BL Offer to the applicable crop types and practices. The offers are available through the sales closing date for soybeans. AIPs process the BL Offers as they would a pre-approved and accepted written agreement, attaching the BL WA number to the insured's policy, and transmitting to RMA within 30 days of the sales closing date.

Producers that miss the sales closing date deadline may have the opportunity to request a new type/practice T/P written agreement request by the acreage reporting date if they did not utilize the BL Offer or have a T/P written agreement for the FAC practice in 2023. A crop inspection may be required if the producer applies after the sales closing date. The rates, yields, and dates offered under a T/P written agreement request will be the same as those offered under a blanket written agreement. All other requirements for a T/P written agreement request apply in accordance with the <u>2024 Written Agreement</u> <u>Handbook (WAH)</u>
